

St. Rose of Lima School Rules

- I. Treat others with the same respect which you are treated by the adults in our school using the commandments and beatitudes as your guide.
- 2. Your actions, dress, possessions, words, etc. may not cause a problem for anyone else and will at all times reflect Christ's love.
- 3. School safety and security rules will be followed at all times.

Bus Rules

These rules apply to all St. Rose Students who may ride Public School Buses or Public transportation such as GTA. These rules will also apply when being transported by a private individual for a school related activity.

Classroom conduct is the accepted behavior on a school bus. Classroom conduct, as used here, is interpreted to mean:

Following the driver's directions, remaining properly seated, keeping your hands and personal items to yourself, and talking with other students in immediate vicinity only. Students need to remember that appropriate language should be used. Drivers/chaperones may separate the students by grades usually with the younger students sitting towards the front of the bus. The driver /chaperones may at any time assign a seat to a student in response to a parent, or student request, to separate students, or to move a student closer to the driver.

GTA Rules

Grant Transit Authority (GTA) has specific rules that apply to anyone who rides their buses. Any person engaging in conduct prohibited by GTA Rules may be immediately removed and prohibited from further access to any and all Grant Transit Authority vehicles.

The GTA Transit Manager shall give written notice to any person excluded from GTA vehicles. The notice shall specify the reason for the exclusion, the scope of the exclusion, the effective date of the exclusion, and the appeal process and may result in Immediate Refusal or Removal. If conditions exist that pose safety or security risks, the rider may be immediately reseated, refused

transportation, or removed from Grant Transit Authority vehicles, facilities and properties.

GTA Discipline for St. Rose Students

The following guidelines may be used in determining the loss of privilege of riding a GTA bus to/from St. Rose School:

First Offense: 1-5 days Second Offense: 2-10 days Third Offense: up to 30 days
