Father is holding a penance service on March 15th at 1:00 for all students who have received 1st communion. For those not able or who do not want to go to confession, there will be time for prayer and reflection. Father makes this so personal to the students. It is a blessing to have our own service. On March 28th at 10:15, students

will be re-enacting the washing of the feet complete with unleavened bread! You are welcome to join us to watch! March 29th is Good Friday. Students will have a procession at 8:45 to cover all the crosses in the school. We will then be doing a live rosary in the gym together. Good Friday is the day Jesus is taken from us. We cover all pictures and crosses to remind us how all followers felt when He was no longer among them physically. At

10:00 we will hold live stations of the cross. Students will model each station as a narrator reads the readings and we follow the Passion of the Lord. We will have chairs up ready for anyone to join us. It is truly a beautiful and holy experience. We have early release this Friday. You will notice the gym lights will be lowered and the mood will be quiet and reverent as we exit the building.
