SCHOOL ADVISORY COUNCIL (SAC)

Nature or Purpose - The overall purpose of the school commission is to advise and support the pastor and principal in the operation of the parish school. School Commissions may be responsible for the following:

Members can serve a term of two (2) years, with three members elected each year (usually) to maintain continuity. Members may serve two (2) consecutive terms. Members must be practicing Catholics and attend weekly mass. Our purpose in this is to encourage SAC's Catholic understanding of apostolic succession and the decision-making authority of the Pastor, by the bishop.

SAC will consist of the following:

- 1) President (nonparent)
- 2) Vice President (nonparent)
- 3) Secretary (nonparent)
- 4) Marketing/Communications (nonparent)
- 5) PDO President
- 6) St. Pius X Church Representative
- 7) Our Lady of Fatima Church Representative
- 8) St Rose of Lima Church Representative
- 9) Catholic Identity & Spirituality Support Representative
- 10) Teacher/Accreditation Team Member (no vote)
- 11) Pastor (no vote)
- 12) Principal (no vote)

We need the highlighted positions filled. SAC meets monthly. If you are interested or know someone who is, please email Mrs. Bafus at sbafus@saintroseschol.org. She will send you the SAC bylaws. After your nominee reads the bylaws and position descriptions, you can meet with current SAC members and have any of your questions answered. Fr. Jose briefly speaks with interested nominees.
