We carefully choose what is needed to meet the specific needs of the students in that class and adjust the curriculum. We are already studying how we will group students and are choosing the appropriate math and reading levels. We work with a reading consultant who is going through our choices to ensure our placements are correct. Our teachers are onboard with being placed where they are needed most. Mrs. Beaulieu will be moving into a teaching assistant position (she needs more time at home 😊), but we are very thankful we will still see her every day. We are actively seeking a new teacher.

We have often had interest in opening a Saint Rose Middle School. In order to move forward with these efforts, we need a middle school team to develop plans and gather information.
